2021 FEE SCHEDULE

School fees/levies are essential for the financial viability of Catholic schools. The school has many financial commitments that rely on the fee income we receive from our families.

Payment Options

Fees are billed annually in February and are due **in full within 30 days** unless you have a Request to Pay School Fees by Instalment or a Fee Concession in place.

CATHOLIC EDUCATION DIOCESE OF WOLLONGONG TUITION FEES & BUILDING LEVY

The Tuition Fee funds teacher's salaries not covered by government funding, and day to day operational costs e.g. electricity, water and insurances. A **Sibling Discount** applies to Tuition Fees for the second, third and subsequent child of a family attending the school. Sibling discounts apply only to students attending the same school.

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T-VET

Course costs are met in a shared arrangement between parents, the school and the Catholic Education Office. The parent contribution will be 25% of the individual course cost for each student.

School fees are invoiced for the appropriate amount when advice is received from TAFE or a relevant provider. This amount will be invoiced to your school fee account and is **due within 30 days** unless you have an arrangement in place.

****course costs are non-refundable as it is a requirement of the training organisation that once a student commences a course the fee is applicable even if the student does not complete the course.**

FAMILY FEES

Parents & Friends Association Levy	\$80	This replaces the need for major fundraising within the school enabling the Parents and Friends to focus on social and parent education initiatives.
School Magazine (GST incl)	\$20	The school commissions the production of a school magazine to celebrate our school community year. It will be issued to each family at the end of the school year.

SCHOOL FEE INVOICING AND PAYMENTS

In accordance with the Diocesan School Fee Management Policy, school fee accounts are issued as an annual invoice, which is due 30 days from the invoice date. Families will still be offered the opportunity of paying their school fees by regular payments over the school year. However, the new system also allows for instalments to be calculated and advised to families with a Schedule of Payments and the dates that they are due. This replaces our current process of School Fee Agreements and the necessity for families to calculate their own payments.

When fees are invoiced and issued in early 2021, you will be provided with a Schedule of Payments and due dates with your school fee statement to enable you to commence payments. Payments by BPay, Centrepay, Credit Card, Cash, Cheque, Compass and EFTPOS are all accepted by the school.

Please note, if you do not elect to pay by instalments, your school fee account will be payable in full 30 days after annual invoicing.

The Diocesan School Fee Management Policy and Request to Pay School Fees by Instalment are available on the schools website. Alternatively, you may access these documents from the school's administration office.

Families who are experiencing genuine financial hardship may apply for Fee Concession by telephoning the school office to obtain an application.
